Due to the Covid 19 pandemic going on at this time, Steam-O-Rama has amended it's usual schedule of events to better follow CDC guidelines for gatherings in Pennsylvania. All current guidelines on social distancing masking and sanitation will be followed to the best of our ability.

Changes to 2020 SOR: There will be no music groups performing this year. This will prevent gathering under the barn area. The usual menu will be served from the kitchen, but tables will be spread all over the area to make social distancing possible. This will also be observed in line to get food.

There will be no tractor feature this year. Ford has been moved to the 2021 season and instead we will have the old fashioned featureless show where all brands are treated equally. Plaques and badges will be issued as usual.

Pulls, exhibits, and demonstrations will be held as usual, but following guidelines. Please bring lawn chairs for the pulls and parades, and for use at the tables that don't have attached benches.

Schedule for 2020 SOR: Thursday, October 1- Free admission. Setup for Flea Market, Steam Engines, Gas Engines, Tractors and Garden Tractors. Food served all day, Registration, Museum and Cook Shack open all day.

Friday, October 2-Usual \$5 admission. All demonstration & displays open all day, flea market, registration and kitchen open. Antique tractor pulls start weighing at 3 and pulling at 5, \$15 hook fee.

Saturday October 3- Usual \$5 Admission. All demonstrations and display open, registration, flea market and kitchen open. Garden tractor fun pull at 9 AM

with a \$5 hook fee. Horse Pulls start at noon and Competitive Garden Tractor pulling starts at 3, pulling 2 sessions with a \$15 hook fee. Purses will be paid.

Sunday, October 4-Free admission. As usual is tear down, pack up and move out. The usual kitchen and registration will be open, but will be closing by mid afternoon. There will be no auction of donated items or raffle ticket drawing this year.

If Pennsylvania status is changed or shut down then we will have to cancel the event. Let's all hope that doesn't happen. Please come prepared to wear your mask, wash your hands and social distance as much as possible.
