We are looking for consignment items for both sale days including sales literature, toys and smaller collectibles, farm equipment, antiques, larger collectibles, tractors and implements, and gas engines and related items. Consignments will be

accepted from Monday May 1 until Friday May 5 at 3 P.M. for evening sale and until 7 P.M. for next day sale. **Deadline for Advertising Is Sunday April 23.**

Items can be delivered on: Saturday April 29 or Sunday April 30 by appointment only, Monday, May 1 to Thursday May 4 from 8 A.M. to dusk. Friday, May 5 small items for the evening sale must be here by 3 P.M. and other items will be accepted throughout the day.

Special arrangements for people traveling long distances can be made with any above member of the sale committee

Our commission rates are competitive. The items you sell will be totaled at the end of the sale. A commission of 20% will be charged on a total of \$100 or less. 15% will be charged on a total of \$101 to \$1000, and 10% will be charged on a total of \$1001 to \$2500 and total over \$2500 will be charged 8% commission. If the total of items sold is less than \$5.00 no check will be issued and the \$5 will be considered a donation to the society. A one time \$10.00 fee will be charged to large and/or advertised items not sold. Arrangements can be made for complete pickup and delivery of items to be consigned for a 20% commission charge or a flat \$100 hauling fee, to be decided on a case by case basis.

Our auctioneers are all volunteer and include, as available, Dave Conley, Jeremiah Herbst, Ton Klinedinst, Marlette Thomas, Charlie and Scott Wehrley, Fred Toomey, Tom Saylor, Josh Mego, Elam King and others. Advertising for the sale will appear in the York Dispatch, York Daily Record, and Lancaster Farming, along with handbills and our newsletter. Deadline for newspaper advertising will be Sunday April 23..
